

**Marty Skemp Brown, MBA-HCA**

Marty Skemp Brown is a Policy Analyst and Grants Manager at the Pain & Policy Studies Group (PPSG), located within the Paul P. Carbone Comprehensive Cancer Center at the University of Wisconsin School of Medicine and Public Health. Ms. Skemp Brown joined the PPSG full time in August 2011 but has been working in the pain field for 13 years.

Prior to joining the Pain & Policy Studies Group, Ms. Skemp Brown was the Associate Director for the Alliance of State Pain Initiatives (ASPI), a national organization working on the barriers to appropriate pain management in the United States. Her role at the ASPI included grants and project management, fund raising and strategic planning. She also oversaw the development, allocation and implementation of grants to State Pain Initiatives to address pain management barriers in their state. Other ASPI projects included continuing education programs for clinicians (eg, Pain Resource Nurse Train the Trainer), quality improvement projects (Post-Operative Pain Management Project) and policy and advocacy work. Most recently she was involved in the development and implementation of a Prescription Monitoring Program (PMP) analysis.

Ms. Skemp Brown received her Masters of Business Administration in Healthcare Administration from University of Wisconsin-Whitewater and her Bachelors in Business Administration (Marketing and Management, with a specialization in International Business) from the University of Wisconsin-Madison.
